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Stage 2 and Stage 3 2024 Student Use of Digital Devices and Online Services Procedure and Agreement

Dear Parent/Carer.

Purpose

This procedure guides student use of digital devices and online services at our school. Our school acknowledges the educational value of digital devices and online services in supporting and enhancing educational outcomes and student wellbeing. We also recognise they may cause harm if used inappropriately and that we need to support our students to use them in safe, responsible and respectful ways.

Scope

This procedure provides a consistent framework for the safe, responsible and respectful use of digital devices and online services by students in our school. It sets out the shared responsibilities of school staff, students and parents and carers. It also provides a framework to manage potential risks to student safety and wellbeing. This procedure covers student use of digital devices and online services in school-related settings, including on school grounds, at school-related activities and outside of school where there is a clear and close connection between the school and the conduct of students. This procedure covers the use of school provided and personal digital devices and all online services.

Our School's Approach

Each day, students hand in their phones, smart watches or other digital devices into the office. Nords Wharf Public School does not take responsibility and liability for these devices. Students collect their devices, from the office, at the end of each day. Students are not permitted to use their device on school grounds. To help students demonstrate their responsible use of technology, students at Nords Wharf Public School require students to read and sign a student agreement that outlines the school expectations around appropriate, and inappropriate, use of technology. In signing, students acknowledge the school's expectations and accept the identified consequences for any breaches of the student agreement.

Nords Wharf Public School **does not require** students to bring their own devices for learning as we have ensured an adequate supply of school devices. Parents will also sign this agreement.

Responsibilities and obligations

For students

- · Be safe, responsible and respectful users of digital devices and online services, and support their peers to be the same.
- Respect and follow school rules and procedures and the decisions made by staff, knowing that other schools may have different arrangements.
- Communicate respectfully and collaboratively with peers, school staff and the school community and behave in the ways described in the Behaviour Code for Students.

For parents and carers

- · Recognise the role they play in educating their children and modelling the behaviours that underpin the safe, responsible and respectful use of digital devices and online services.
- \cdot Support implementation of the school procedure, including its approach to resolving issues.
- Take responsibility for their child's use of digital devices and online services at home such as use of online services with age and content restrictions.

For the principal and teachers

•Deliver learning experiences that encourage safe, responsible and respectful use of digital devices and online

services.

- · Model appropriate use of digital devices and online services in line with departmental policy.
- Respond to and report any breaches and incidents of inappropriate use of digital devices and online services as required by school procedures, departmental policy and any statutory and regulatory requirements. This includes: reporting the creation, possession or distribution of indecent or offensive material to the Incident Support and Report hotline as required by the Incident Notification and Response Policy and Procedures and consider any mandatory reporting requirements.
- · If feasible and particularly as issues emerge, support parents and carers to understand strategies that promote their children's safe, responsible and respectful use of digital devices and online services.

Student guidelines, procedures and consequences.

Students need to follow the following guidelines and Procedures:

- students hand in their phones, smart watches or other digital devices into the office and collect at the end of the day.
- students are not permitted to take digital devices on school excursions including sporting events.
- · students must engage with technology as safe, responsible and respectful learners as detailed below.

- · Suspension and possible Police and/or Child Wellbeing involvement for serious incidents.
