Information is as follows:

Excursion:	2022 ELMPSSA Zone Athletics Carnival.
Venue:	Hunter Sports Centre 43 Stockland Dr, Glendale NSW 2285
Date:	Wednesday 10 August 2022.
Classes Involved:	Year 2 – 6 students that qualified.
Cost of Excursion is:	\$7.40 per student to be paid at school. Please only pay the difference from fees already paid, for example, if you paid \$2 already please send in \$5.40. \$2.00 per spectator to be paid upon entry. Please note the updated pricing. This is due to the change of venue and their hire fee.
Travel will be by:	Private Transport.
Times:	Students are to arrive by 8:30am. Look for the NWPS flag. Students are to locate Mrs Chevalley or Mrs Brown upon arrival to get marked off the roll. The day will conclude at approximately 2:30pm. The event schedule will be posted on Seesaw as soon as it is confirmed. *Those who have qualified for the 1500m event, please arrive prior to 8am.
The group will be supervised by:	Mrs Chevalley and Mrs Brown
Please provide:	Full school sport uniform with borrowed sports singlet. Students can wear spikes only for certain events. If you are wanting to wear spikes, please see Mrs Chevalley to find out if they are permitted for your child's event. Students are encouraged to provide a packed lunch, recess and snacks and water for the day. However, there will be a canteen operating throughout each day for any purchases. Please leave all unnecessary money and valuables at home. Anything you choose to bring you do so at your own risk. NWPS will not take responsibility for any valuables that are lost, broken, or stolen.
