RE: Stage 3 Canberra Excursion

We are happy to confirm that the Stage 3 Canberra Excursion will be going ahead as planned, as we had an over whelming response from parents wanting their child to attend and wanting to keep the snow day as part of the excursion.

When: Tuesday 4 August to Friday 7 August 2020 (Term 3 Week 3).

Where: Canberra and Perisher.

Time: Students will be required to be at school at 6:00am Tuesday morning and will

return to school at approximately 8:30pm Friday night.

Transport: Air-conditioned, seat belt equipped coach and driver.

Accommodation: 3 nights at Canberra Park Resort (linen and towels provided).

Staff: Mr Cutts, Mr Wootton and Ms Corrigan.

As the final cost of the excursion has been calculated (based on the number of students attending) the school is now subsidising \$65 per child. The school is also claiming the PACER Rebate of \$20 per student. As previously stated the total cost to parents is set at \$545 however, students are excited to start fundraising to help reduce this amount.
