I'm sure you have noticed that Nords Wharf PS has had a 'facelift' over the holidays! There has been a significant amount of work done both through Schools Infrastructure and by Mr Mandl and the teaching staff. The works included –

- A complete renovation of the 2/3 classroom including a new roof, all flooring, painting and the installation of a sink area
- Painting the Office, Kindergarten classroom, K/1 classroom and 4/5 classroom
- New carpet and vinyl in the 4/5 classroom
- Painting, removal of old sink and gas heating and flooring in the room next to Kindergarten

- A significant amount of new fencing
- Clearing an asset protection zone behind the demountables
- A large amount of tree works
- Repairing and upgrading parts of the fixed equipment

As some areas were only finished being painted and carpeted last week, we are still in the process of unpacking and are awaiting the delivery of new furniture and the collection of furniture that is no longer needed.
